All-India Run: Join participants from all over the country who are motivated to raise awareness about HIV in India. Medals will be awarded to the top finishers in three categories. Members of affected communities and other stakeholders will speak and officiate the run.

Activities begin at **10am** at **Safdarjung Tomb**. The All-India Run will start at **11am**, and the Cultural Event will take place immediately following the race on the grounds of **Delhi Blind School** and will last until **4pm**.

Cultural Event: Celebrating life and creativity in the face of the epidemic, the cultural event will consist of music and drama performances. The jazz and rock bands invited have members from communities affected by the epidemic. Skits between music acts will highlight issues of at-risk groups. Lunch will be available. In addition, stalls will present the work of sponsors and other organisations addressing HIV/AIDS and supporting communities.

This event is open to the public. There is no fee for participation. Participants are encouraged to wear **red** or **white**, but all will be welcomed.
